

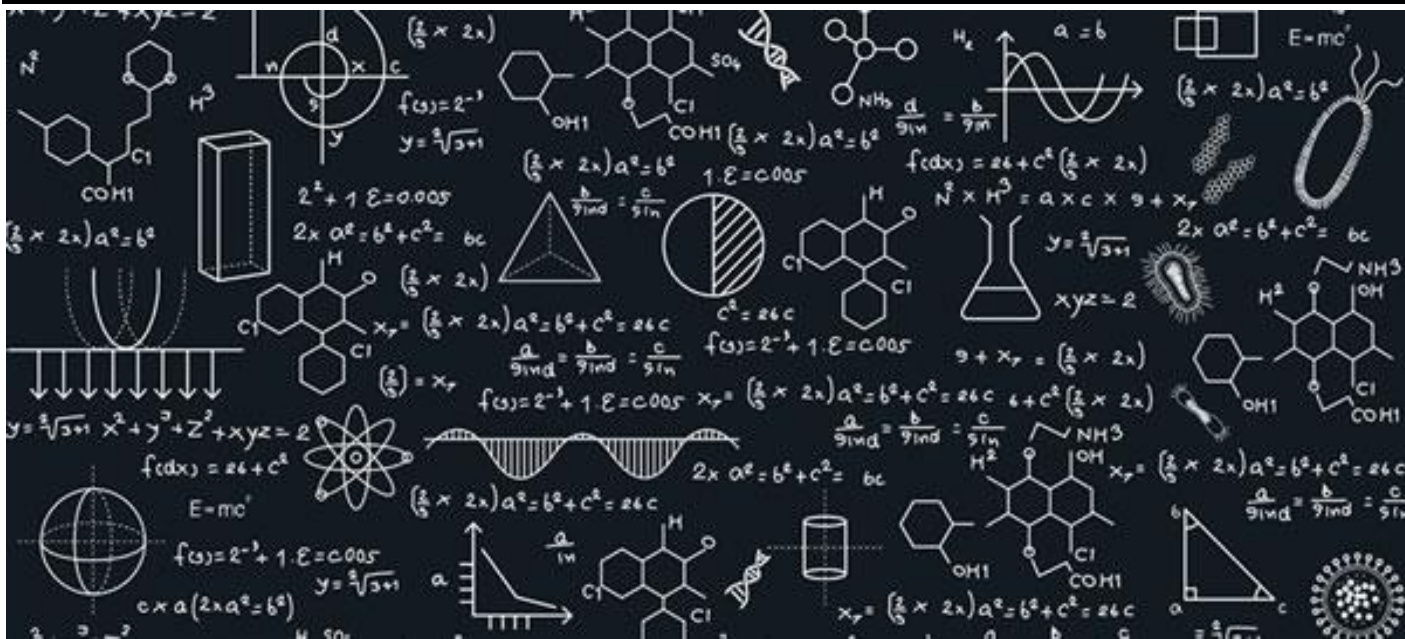

NEXT STEPS

- 1) Expand your Leadership Team with more Key Team Leaders
- 2) Create Men's Ministry Annual Calendar
- 3) Meet with Pastor(s) and Youth Pastor
- 4) Register your Local Church Men's Ministry with Wingman Nation.
- 5) If you are a Methodist Church, charter your Men' Ministry with GCUMM.

1. *Expand your Leadership Team with more Key Team Leaders.*
2. *With your expanded leadership team create a professional looking month-by-month calendar for the next year to print and share in person, then email as well. Tentative dates are always fine. This document should act as an invitational piece that should have information about the ministry (Mission Statement), how to contact the leadership, and possibly more.*
3. *Meet with our pastor(s) and our youth pastor to find out how our men's ministry can serve our Local Church and Community. What ways can our men's ministry support them?*
4. *Register your Local Church Men's Ministry with Wingman Nation. The initial cost for the first year is \$150 and every year afterwards is \$50. This gives your Men's Ministry unlimited access to the world's largest library of video-based Christian Bible studies, including hundreds specifically for men: Rightnow Media. A great investment in growing your men closer to Christ with modern, exciting programming.*
5. *If your Church is a Methodist Church, officially charter your Local Church men's ministry through the General Commission of United Methodist Men. The Annual cost is \$85. It is a great investment for the connection that allows you to learn from and share ideas with UMC men's ministries around the world. Download form at <http://www.gcumm.org/support/chartering>*

Make every effort to add future leaders that you can mentor to prepare for your men's ministry's future. Assign specific responsibilities to reach more men and to professionally execute the plans on your calendar. Your leadership team will need to be organized with responsibilities such as:

- Communications to men (Email, Phone and Social Media)
- Regular Meal Planning & Operations (possibly multiple teams)
- Special Events Planning & Operations (possibly one primary leader per major event)
- Annual Men's Conferences, Seminars and Workshops
- *****Each of these leadership positions will need a team to help execute their objectives*****
